**2 Tim. 4: 6-8, 17-18:** Having spent himself fully serving the vocation given to him by Christ, Paul now writes of his approaching death with resignation and gratitude.

**Matt. 16: 13-19:** Inspired by God, Peter acknowledges Christ to be the Messiah, the Anointed One, and is declared to be the Leader in succession to Christ of the Christian community.

## THE FEAST OF SAINTS PETER & PAUL

These two saints were contemporaries. Peter was a disciple of Jesus and chosen by Christ to lead the Church. Paul had been a zealous Jew who persecuted Christians, before experiencing a dramatic conversion on the road to Damascus and becoming the Church's first great missionary. Through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom, saints Peter and Paul helped to establish Christ's Church.

"Christian tradition has always considered Saints Peter and Saint Paul to be inseparable: indeed, together, they represent the whole Gospel of Christ." (*Pope Benedict XVI*)

#### Second Collection: This weekend is for Peter's Pence.

It is an offering that may be small, but is of great symbolic value:

It expresses the sense of belonging to the Church and **love and trust for the Holy Father**. It is a tangible sign of communion with Him, as Peter's Successor, and also of attention to the needs of the most disadvantaged, for whom the Pope always cares.
