#### Enthusiasm

Commitment is a word we often hear used in homilies and pep-talks and, invariably, we are encouraged to be enthusiastic about that on which we have set our minds. Today's readings, emphatically, speak to us of the need to be enthusiastic in our commitment to Christian beliefs and practices.

**Isaiah 66:10-14** The Babylonian exile has ended. The Israelites are to return to Israel and to Jerusalem. Both country and city have been devastated during the years of exile; and now, they must set themselves to the task of reconstruction. Isaiah is telling them that they must overcome their initial discouragement and become positive in their attitudes to the task of rebuilding, drawing strength from their sense of commitment as God's Chosen Ones.

**Galatians 6: 14-18** Nothing stifles progress more than division. The early Christian community, consisting of converts from Judaism and non-Jewish traditions, was divided on the matter of circumcision. Paul encourages them to overcome their differences in the light of the common bond that exists because of their Baptism.

Luke 10: 1-12 17-20 The call by Christ to the 72 disciples highlights the urgency of the harvest and the need for labourers, emphasizing that disciples should be humble, reliant on God, and proclaim the nearness of God's kingdom. The passage also speaks to the authority given to the disciples, their joy in serving, and the importance of focusing on their relationship with God rather than worldly success.

#### A Christian missionary

Missionary zeal does not grow out of intellectual beliefs, nor out of theological arguments, but out of love. A Christian missionary is a pilgrim who walks under the scorching sun without a bag or sack and sandals and who knocks asking for hospitality. A worker who works so hard all day and, in the evening, awaits the right reward.

Obedience, generosity, poverty, detachment, charity are themes that flow before our eyes, outlining the true face of a missionary. But there is an annotation that in particular seems to seal the role of the Christian

mission: "Cure the sick and say: the kingdom of God is at hand to you!". The two fundamental dimensions of Christian commitment appear here, the "horizontal" one of fraternal charity (cure the sick) and the "vertical" one of the announcements of the Kingdom of God.

"The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into His harvest."- Luke 10:2 God wills and commands missions. He made missions possible through His Son. He made missions actual in sending the Holy Spirit.
